Dear Parishioner,

As you may have noticed the Methodist Church has decided to dispose of the Wesleyan Sabbath School by informal tender. It was previously hoped that Withernwick Parish Council would have been offered first refusal on the building however this is contrary to the Methodists policy.

The building is the last remaining meeting room within the village and is regularly used by the Derby & Joan Club, The Withernwick Ladies Group, Withernwick Parish Council and Withernwick Community Association to name but a few. It is for this reason that the Parish Council is very committed in retaining this essential community building.

The principle of the Parish Council purchasing the School Room is to be discussed during the next Parish Council Meeting. This is to take place at the School Room on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> January from 7pm**. Your views in respect of this matter would be greatly welcomed at this point.
