


ALDBROUGH W.I.

It's amazing what can be made from unused theatre drapes and gauze. Jane's talk was most informative. Numerous questions were asked about the experiences that Jane had encountered. 

News from John Witty: The other day we had a flock of pink footed geese flying north back to their breeding grounds in Iceland and they would stop off in Scotland to feed up and rest for a few days, must have been 500+. Also thousands of guillemots on the cliffs and the sea and a small number of razorbills are back, give them a few weeks there will be thousands of them and our famous gannets are back and rafts of kittiwakes on the sea so Spring can't be far away with this happing again, also a few skylarks about and the tree sparrows are taking a interest in the nest boxes and under the tiles of the roof, the shop at the visitors centre. Plus the birds of prey kestrel hunting down near the cliffs, the sparrow hawk is always hunting round the bird feeding station looking for an easy meal. All the footpaths to the cliffs have been done up, better walking down to the cliffs and been made a bit wider for those in wheelchairs or mobility scooters and the CCTV cameras are being put back up too this year so visitors will able to see more of what is going on the cliffs.
