

A CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM OUR ARCHBISHOP - Living well

One of my great joys in life is cooking. I love being able to share food and look forward to cooking a Christmas dinner for the staff at Bishopthorpe. It is a simple joy to eat the fruit and vegetables of the season – such as sprouts, parsnips and red cabbage. Although we can buy fresh strawberries, broccoli and cucumbers all year round – this convenience comes at a cost. In making our lives more convenient, we risk making the life of the rest of creation, both now and in the future, that much more difficult.

In the Genesis Creation story, human beings are not given ownership of creation, but rather stewardship. 
