#### Sent in by Doreen Dunn: (Revd Matthew Martinson's grandma!): HAYLEY'S HEART ATTACK FLAPJACK (Hayley Martinson)

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> lb butter/margarine; <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> jar golden syrup; 8oz plain flour; 12oz porridge oats; 4oz brown sugar; 1heaped tsp bicarbonate of soda; 1 heaped tsp baking powder; sultanas/currants/driedfruit may be added Method: Line a deep baking tin/grill pan/roasting dish and preheat oven to 180/Gas4 Place flour, sugar, oats, baking powder, dried fruit in large mixing bowl. In a large saucepan, put in the butter and syrup, and melt tog. over a low heat until runny. Sprinkle the bicarb over the runny mixture and stir until it becomes frothy.
Pour the mixture onto dry ingredients and mix well. Tip the mixture into the tin and spread out with the back of a hot spoon, the mixture will be quite moist. Bake for about 25 mins till golden.
Pat the top of the flapjack with a spoon esp around the edges and leave to cool before turning out and slicing. This flapjack freezes brilliantly.

I always have a bag in the freezer - for when the vicar calls!
