Orkney became part of the kingdom of Scotland in the years 1468, and 1486 was given into care of the people of Kirkwall by the Scottish king James III. Today the cathedral remains the property of the people of Orkney. The Orkney island council spends more then £120,000 a year running the cathedral, and other large sums of money are spent on major repairs as they are needed. They have a 100,000 victors a year, it is suggested the each visitor might donate £1-00 towards the upkeep of this very old and full history.
