As you can see, some are doing very well, others are not. They think the main reason is that the puffin lives on sand eels and they are having to travel farther out to sea to find them. On the Farne Isands rspb are tagging some puffins with a small radio transmitter so they will know where they go to find the sand eels and how deep they dive, also where they winter as the north sea and north Atlantic are very big. As you can see the puffin numbers are a lot down. The gannets always do very well as they catch all sorts of fish and feed in deeper water about 20 miles out to sea
