

I hope some of you did the RSPB big garden birdwatch for an hour on the 30 or 31 Jan. I did and had a very good count: black birds 12, goldfinch 10, sparrows 15, robin 1, bluetits 6, great tit1, starlings 5, chaffinches 4, wagtail pied 1, which is not really a garden bird so very pleased with myself, and sent to the RSPB via their web page. Also we have the guillemots back on the cliffs in big numbers but they come and be gone the next day. This year, I am hopefully going to take some walks at Bempton. Nick and Clare say they will be very pleased for me to do some walks and should find it more interesting. At the moment there are a lot of waders on the Humber banks from Paull Holme to Stone Creek you should see curlew redshank, dunlin knot oystercatcher and maybe the avocat could go on for ever more. But the best is to go and have a look yourself, and remember you want some warm clothes on as I know it can be very cold if the wind is off the sea.
